CATHEDRAL SUPPORTS EFFORT TO END CHRONIC HOMELESSNESS

How's Nashville is a community-wide, collaborative, and inclusive effort to end chronic homelessness in Nashville within this decade. It was launched by the Metropolitan Homeless Commission at the beginning of June and has a goal of raising \$200,000 within 90 days to house 200 of the most vulnerable and chronically homeless individuals and families in the Nashville community. It takes \$1,000 per homeless individual to cover move-in costs. The Community Outreach Committee has voted to give \$1,000 from the Outreach Opportunity Fund so that Christ Church Cathedral can be a sponsor for one homeless individual to move off of the street and into an apartment. Christ Church Cathedral joins many other Nashville faith-based communities, businesses and individuals in this city-wide effort to end chronic homelessness.
