THE REVEREND DR. WALTER BRUEGGEMANN**

Dr. Brueggemann is known throughout the world for his method of combining literary and sociological modes when reading the Bible. He is the William Marcellus McPheeters Professor Emeritus of Old Testament at Columbia Theological Seminary. He is a past president of the Society of Biblical Literature and an ordained minister in the United Church of Christ.
