
smile, sometimes a prayer, and a recommendation of where they can find a meal.

The Reverend Dr. Bryan is a priest, writer, scholar, and actor, born in London, England. He served in Sewanee as the C. K. Benedict Professor of New Testament and the editor of the Sewanee Theological Review. He holds a Ph.D. from Exeter University, studied for the priesthood at Ripon Hall Theological College in Oxford, and was awarded a Doctor of Divinity, honoris causa from the University of the South in recognition of his service to the church and the academy. Throughout this period, the works of C. S. Lewis and Charles Williams were-and continue to be-major influences on him. Among his most important non-fiction books are Resurrection of the Messiah, Render to Caesar, And God Spoke: The Authority of the Bible for the Church Today, and Listening to the Bible: The Art of Faithful Biblical Interpretation. His fiction works include Siding Star, named by Kirkus Review as one of the Best Books of 2013, Peacekeeper, Singularity, A Habit of Death, and The Dogleg Murders.
