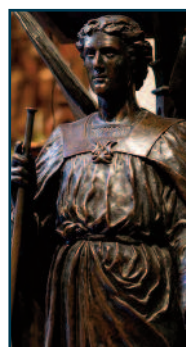
WELCOMING EVENT FOR THE REVEREND LISSA SMITH

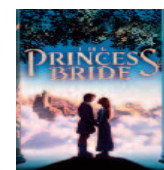

ADULT EDUCATION OFFERING THE ENNEAGRAM FROM A CHRISTIAN PERSPECTIVE: AN INTRODUCTION

The Enneagram, which is derived from the Greek words ἕννεα (ennéa, meaning “nine”) and γράμμα (grámma, meaning something “written” or “drawn”), is a unique tool for cultivating self-awareness and facilitating personal and spiritual growth. Parishioner Susan Hilderbrand will introduce the enneagram, discuss its origins, explore the three Centers of Intelligence and the nine virtues associated with each enneagram point. Susan has been studying the enneagram for the past three years and completed her enneagram certification this summer. The class will include a brief overview of each participant's enneagram type. The group will be limited to 15 participants, and our approach will be supportive and experiential, using body and breath-work, poetry and song, lecture and discussion, as resources.

The group will meet weekly on Wednesday evenings from 6 -8 p.m. at the Diocesan House (3700 Woodmont Blvd, 37215) on September 13, 20, 27, October 4 and 11, 2017 for a total of five meetings. To register, please email Melinda Balser, mbalser@christcathedral.org

EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY (EfM)

Education for Ministry (EfM) is a course created by the University of the South School of Theology at Sewanee that invites participants to study scripture, theology, and church history and tradition. Within a small group setting, each individual explores the part he or she is meant to play in the fullness of God's world. Members of Christ Church Cathedral facilitate the classes, which meet once a week over the course of the school year for study, conversation, and reflection. Classes meet on Tuesday evening or Wednesday morning, but a third class may be added if there is sufficient interest. Although the course offers four years, students sign up for one year at a time, and enrollment for 2017-2018 is currently open. The registration deadline is August 1, but since space is limited, those interested in participating are encouraged to register as soon as possible.
