- Encourage people to vote (Tennessee is 50th out of 50 in voter turnout!)

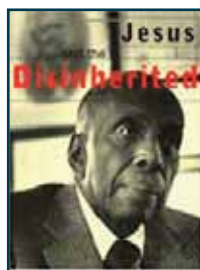
