Michael Kleinschmidt is the Canon Musician of Saint Mark's Cathedral, Seattle, Washington, where he oversees the ministries of six choirs and plays the landmark Flentrop pipe organ. Before assuming this role in March 2015, he served as Canon Musician of Trinity Cathedral, Portland, Oregon. Prior to moving to Oregon in 2010, he was Director of Music and Organist of Trinity Church, Copley Square, Boston. As a concert organist, Michael has performed in forty-two states of America, and in Canada, Europe, and Japan. As a choral conductor, he has served as guest conductor for summer choir courses of the Royal School of Church Music/America. Michael's primary mentor in church music was the late Gerre Hancock, with whom he worked as Assistant Organist of Saint Thomas Church, New York City, in the early

1990s. Michael holds degrees in organ performance from the Oberlin Conservatory of Music and the Eastman School of music. His teachers were Haskell Thomson and Russell Saunders.

In addition to his professional activities, Mr. Kleinschmidt enjoys exploring the natural wonders of the Pacific Northwest on foot or bicycle.
