

EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY (EFM) FALL OFFERINGS

EfM classes invite participants to study scripture, theology, and church history and tradition. Within a small group setting, each individual explores the part he or she is meant to play in the fullness of God's world.



Although the course offers four years of study, students sign up for one year at a time. The enrollment fee is \$375.00. Some scholarship money is available. This fall Christ Church Cathedral will offer two EfM classes. A Wednesday morning class will meet from 8:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. in Room 4 in the Atrium beginning on August 29. 


