THE REVEREND DR. CHRISTOPHER BEELEY AS THE
GUEST PREACHER AT THE 8:30 AND 11:00 A.M. LITURGIES
THIS MORNING**

The Reverend Dr. Christopher Beeley is professor of theology at Duke Divinity School. He also serves as the Jack and Barbara Bovender Professor of Anglican Episcopal Studies and Ministry, and director of the Anglican Episcopal House of Studies. He holds a B.A. from Washington and Lee University, an M.Div. from Yale Divinity School, and a Ph.D. from the University of Notre Dame. Dr. Beeley's interdisciplinary expertise in early Christianity bridges the gap between historical and theological studies, with an increasing focus in constructive theology. Dr. Beeley will also be the speaker at the Dean's Forum at 9:45 a.m. in the Parish Hall.
