

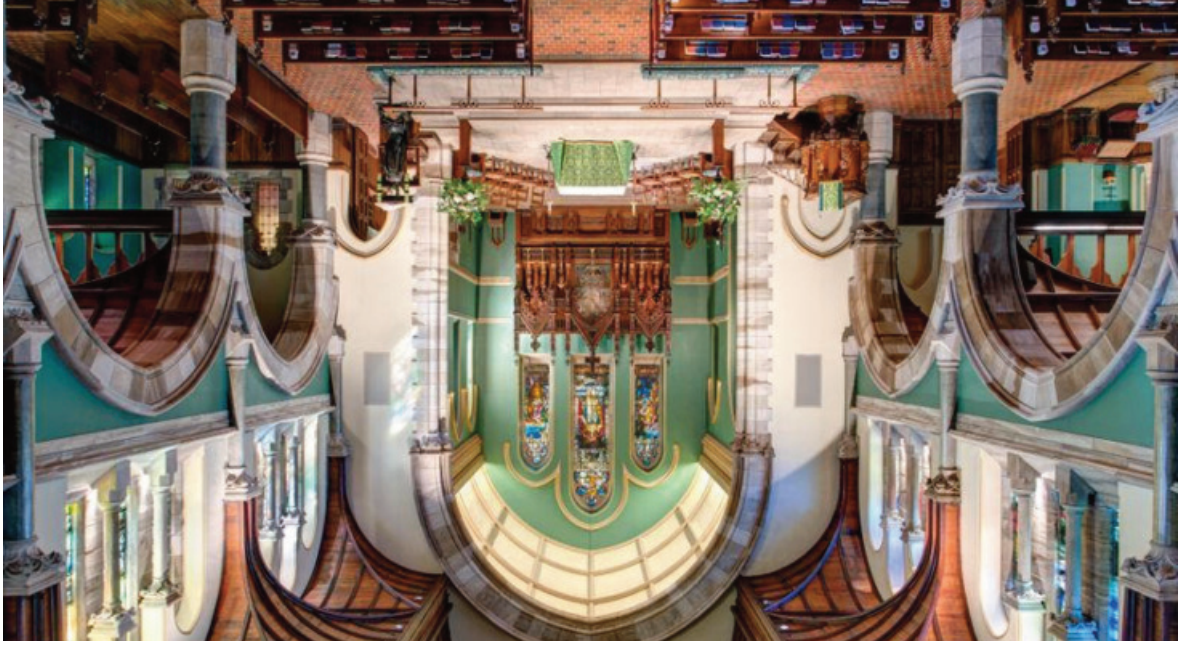

MEET THE NOMINEES



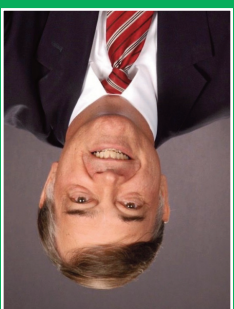
JOHN BRIDGES

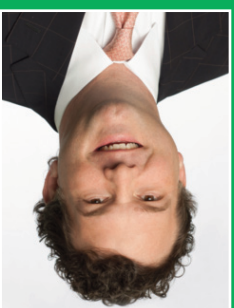
DAVID HANSEN
