Clarkson Fogg Melby Stewart and Balling  
it was

3<sup>d</sup> Resolved that the Meeting will purchase  
a lot of ground for the purpose of erecting  
thereon a Church Building and that  
they will purchase of Mr Jas Stewart  
sixty four front on Church or Spring the  
sum of one hundred and eighty feet on the  
line of the Street set for the  
sum of twenty four hundred dollars per  
thousand to be paid in eight months  
and the balance in two annual payments  
with interest from the first of January  
next.

4<sup>t</sup> Resolved that Miss Clarkson Melby  
and Stewart be a building Committee  
and that they are authorized to receive  
proposals for and superintend the erection  
of the Church Belfry on the above  
lot — — — — —  
adjourned
