At a meeting of the Vestry of St. Luke's Church

to attend the Synodical Convention to be
held in Marion on the first of July

- 3^d Resolved that the V'tyng will purchase
a lot of ground for the purpose of erecting
thereon a Sumner edifice and that
they will purchase of Mr Jas Hewart
sixty feet front on Church or Spring the
running back eighty feet on High that
the term of the Hewart lot for the
sum of twenty five hundred dollars or
thereabouts to be paid in eight months
and the balance in two annual payments
with interest from the first of January
next
- 4th Resolved that Messrs Claiborne Shelby
and Stewart be a building committee
and that they are authorized to receive
proposals for and superintend the erection
of the Church edifice on the above
lot —————
