

At a meeting of the congregation of Church
^{Rev. G. A. L. for the choir}
 Laurels held on Monday the 25th July 1836
 it was resolved, Unanimously, that the
 congregation proceed to the election of vestry
 men to hold their office until the next regular
 election - in consequence of there having been
 none chosen on Easter Monday last.
 After counting the ballots the following persons
 were declared to be duly elected by the President,
 viz. John Shelby, M. Watson, C. D. Hicks, F. B. Pogg,
 James Diggons, D. Williams, Kemp & G. M. Pogg.

At a meeting of the vestry held immediately
 after the election, Present The Rector, & Messrs Watson
 F. B. Pogg, Diggons, Williams & G. M. Pogg.
 G. M. Pogg was duly elected Treasurer and
 Secretary for the ensuing year & Messrs Shelby
 & Kemp church Wardens.

A communication was then made by the
 Rector upon the subject of his salary, after
 which he retired.

The vestry took the same into considera-
 tion and appointed Messrs Watson, F. B. & G. M. Pogg
 a committee to consult upon the subject and
 report to a subsequent meeting of the vestry
 adjourned
