At a meeting of the vestry of Christ Church held this day present Messrs Shelly, F. B. Fogg, G. M. Fogg, M. Watson, Baird & Martin
On Motion it was resolved that the subject of electing a rector for said church in the place of the Rev. J. Wheat be taken up & Dr Shelly proposed for that office the Rev. Charles Jones of St Louis. & but before any vote was taken the meeting adjourned until Saturday the 14th inst. Mr Baird sec pro tem

At a meeting of the vestry of Christ Church held this day present Messrs F. B. Fogg, M. Watson & G. M. Martin. The subject of electing a rector was called up when the Rev Charles Jones was elected unanimously & Mr F. B. Fogg was requested to notify him of his election & adj^d

At a subsequent day the Rev Charles Jones sent his letter accepting the offer of rector of Christ Church & on the 14th of Nov. he was regularly installed by the Bishop of this diocese

Nashville December 4th 1848

At a meeting of the Vestry of Christ Church called by the Rector, and held this day, the following members being present, J. B. Fogg, E. M. Fogg, W. Watson and Bro. Baird;

Bro. Baird was elected Secretary and the following resolutions adopted. viz. —

Resolved, that the salary of the present Rector of this parish shall be Twelve Hundred Dollars per annum, commencing from the 1st of November last, and payable quarterly by the treasurer from the proceeds of the Lev. Tax.

Resolved, that whereas it appears to the satisfaction of the Vestry that Tho. Eastland and Joseph Green, some time since relinquished their pews to the church, under the impression that they had bought the pew of the late Geo. Wilson, but have never received any title to the same from the said Wilson, and the pew of said Eastland No. 12, which he formerly occupied being now vacant.

It is therefore ordered that the said Eastland and Green be notified that they can return to said pew No. 12, and occupy the same subject to the tax assessed upon it from the present date.
