

At a meeting of the congregation of Christ Church held on Easter Monday April 9<sup>th</sup> 1855 the Rector in the chair the persons hereinafter named were duly elected Vestry men for the ensuing ecclesiastical year on the first ballot D. B. Fogg, John Shelby & James Diggon were elected - but no choice for the remainder - the congregation then proceeded to another ballot, but before it was closed, on motion of Mr Kenet, the meeting adjourned until to morrow, Tuesday at 4 o'clock P.M.

April 10<sup>th</sup> On Tuesday afternoon 4 o'clock the congregation met according to adjournment and after prayer by the Rector, Mr A. McKenzie was elected Secretary of the meeting - when the congregation proceeded to ballot for four vestry men - upon calling the ballots it was found that M. Watson John Roberts, G. M. Fogg & R. Howton were duly elected having a majority of all the votes cast - The Rector then declared that the vestry for the ensuing year consisted of the persons hereinafter named viz; John Shelby, D. B. Fogg, James Diggon, M. Watson John Roberts, G. M. Fogg & R. Howton
