

At a meeting of the Vestry held at
H. B. Fogg's office on Saturday 11 April 1863
President

H. B. Fogg, J. M. Fogg, R. H. Weston, C. Cassier,
J. Kitchman, J. Bankhead & A. Crawford
on motion of H. B. Fogg (do. Moderator)
the following resolutions were unanimously
adopted,

"Resolved" That the thanks of the Vestry
and Congregation of Christ Church Wash DC
be given to Mr. Bankhead, and through
him to the other members of the "Choir" for
their kindness and generosity in donating
their great talents and genius for Music
to the Service of the Church, and that the
deepest gratitude is felt for their disinte-
rested and liberal exertions."
