quartette, and suggesting that as Mr.
Walbourne would be director of both
voices and organist he should be
consulted as to the selection of

Resolved that Messrs Bransford and Mitchell be authorized to see Messrs Benedict and Bush with the object of effecting a settlement of account due them on the most satisfactory basis possible. Resolved that the card and envelope system of weekly offerings be urged upon the congregation and the proper items be provided at the expense of the Parish by the Rector and Treasurer at the next conference.
